



Curly Mitchell Grass *Astrelba lappacea*



We are pleased to offer this important perennial native grass, widely known to graziers as an excellent grazing and pasture species, but also ideal for use in revegetation works by mining, civil and roadside concerns.

Astrelba lappacea is endemic to the eastern and central Australian region and is one of the most stable and economically important pasture species in the semi – arid regions of eastern Australia.

The seed has been collected from north west NSW and is an extremely good line testing 88.6% purity, 77% germination and guaranteed weed free.

- Perennial native grass
- 30 – 90 cm height
- Long lived – up to 30 years
- Extremely palatable to livestock, even when dry
- Widespread colonizer in all semi – arid regions of eastern Australia
- Crude protein 5 – 11%
- Phosphorus 0.21 – 0.43%
